  - c. The submitted efficacy data will support a 6-week claim for killing preadult fleas. However, the submitted data will not support a 6-week claim for kill of adult fleas. The data show that the product will kill adult fleas for 6 weeks, but that repeat treatment for adults may be needed before 6 weeks. As a result, it should be stated on the label that repeat treatment is required.

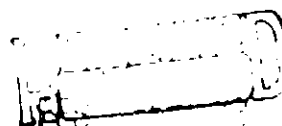

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Contains aromatic petroleum solvent. Call a physician immediately. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine only by injection is an antidote. *Product contains aromatic petroleum distillate.*  
If on skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Remove and wash any contaminated clothing.  
If in eyes: Flush eyes with water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists.  
If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING**

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

Hot Shot Flea & Tick Exterminator kills fleas on contact, and keeps killing for 6 weeks. Kills adult and preadult fleas.

**TO KILL FLEA AND BROWN DOG TICKS IN CARPETING, RUGS, UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE AND PET RESTING AREAS:** Begin treatment at furthest point from doorway to the room. Direct spray downward toward rugs and carpeting. Thoroughly apply in a slow, sweeping motion, holding can 18"-24 inches from treated surface and working toward doorway. Spray surfaces at a rate of 90 seconds for every 100 square feet. Spray exterior and underneath upholstered furniture. Also spray underneath removable cushions, in closets and wherever else these insects are seen or suspected. Avoid excessive wetting of surfaces. Leave treated area and do not return for one hour. Do not allow children or pets to walk on treated surfaces until they are completely dry. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. For maximum results put off cleaning carpets, floors and furniture with detergents or cleansers for one week. Vacuuming, however, will not affect treated surfaces. Hot Shot Flea & Tick Exterminator leaves a non-staining residue which keeps killing for 6 weeks.

**TO KILL FLEA AND TICKS AROUND PET AREAS:** Remove and destroy pets' old bedding. Spray sleeping areas of pets, around baseboards, wall cracks and local areas of floors. **DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS.** Put fresh bedding in pets' quarters after spray has dried. Treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick pet product before allowing them to enter treated area.
