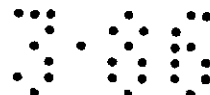

NAOCL 13.4% (100% available chlorine) 2.50%
DIMEHYLTERE 3.0% 0.60%

INERT INGREDIENTS

Water 97.50%
Fragrance 0.50%
Sodium Hydroxide 1.20%
Sulfuric Acid 0.80%

When used as directed, this disinfectant cleans and deodorizes surfaces. It is not intended for use on food or food contact surfaces. Do not mix with washing liquid.

DIRECTIONS

1. For cleaning and deodorizing walls, floors, counter-tops, and similar surfaces, add 2 oz. Spur-Tex Disinfectant Cleaner-Deodorant to a gallon of water. Thoroughly wet all treated surfaces with cloth, sponge, or mop, dipped in solution.
2. For maximum cleaning and disinfecting, add 4 oz. Spur-Tex Disinfectant Cleaner-Deodorant per gallon of water. Thoroughly wet all treated surfaces.
3. For controlling growth of mold (on food or fungi) on walls, floors, counters, and similar surfaces, clean surface thoroughly with wire or mop, with sponge or brush saturated with solution of 4 oz. of Spur-Tex Disinfectant Cleaner-Deodorant to 1 gal. water, and apply liberally after cleaning. When new growth appears, rinse all food contact surfaces with potable water before use.
