The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with comments.

- To update the label for compliance with the container rule for EPA registrations.

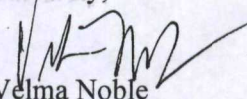
Conditions

- Revise the Precautionary Statements to read: "...Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling *and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet...*".
- Revise the Container Disposal section to read: "Non-refillable container. Do not reuse *or refill* this container. Offer for recycling..."
- Revise the Residue Removal Instruction to read: "...Repeat procedure two more times. *Than offer for recycling or reconditioning.*"
- Replace the HIV-1 label statement with the following: "*Kills HIV-1 on pre-cleaned environmental surfaces/objects previously soiled with blood/body fluids" in which there is expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects..."

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear chemical goggles, protective clothing, and rubber gloves. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

FIRST AID

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

If in eyes: Hold eye open, rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **If on skin or clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **If swallowed:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Open dumping is prohibited. Store only in original container. Do not reuse empty container. If a leaky container must be contained within another, mark the outer container to identify the contents. Store pesticides away from food, pet food, feed, seed, fertilizers, and veterinary supplies. Keep this product under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse this container to hold materials other than pesticides or diluted pesticides. RESIDUE REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS: Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Fill container 1/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Follow Pesticide Disposal instructions for rinsate disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat procedure two more times.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Before using this product, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected.

DISINFECTION PERFORMANCE IN NON-MEDICAL FACILITIES: At 2 ounces per gallon of water this product is bactericidal against *Salmonella enterica*, *Staphylococcus aureus*.

Cleaning and Deodorizing: Prepare a use solution of 2 ounces of Spur-TEX Disinfectant Cleaner-Deodorant per gallon of water. Apply solution to thoroughly wet surfaces with a cloth, sponge, or mop. Allow to air dry.

Disinfection: Pre-clean hard nonporous surfaces. Apply use solution of Spur-TEX Disinfectant Cleaner-Deodorant, 4 oz per gallon of water, as to thoroughly wet surfaces with a cloth, sponge, or mop. Allow treated surfaces to remain wet for 10 minutes, then allow to air dry or remove excess liquid with cloth or sponge. Fresh solution must be prepared daily or more often if solution becomes visibly diluted or soiled.

Rinse all food contact surfaces such as tables and counters with potable water. Do not use on dishes, glasses, utensils or interior surfaces of appliances.
