PLEASANTLY SCENTED. Hours of protection from mosquitoes. Also repels gnats, black, sand and stable flies, ticks, and chiggers. Spray on skin or clothing. Also spray on screens to discourage entrance of such insects.

DIRECTIONS

Point valve toward surface to be sprayed. Hold nozzle about 18 inches from surface. Apply sufficient spray to all exposed skin to leave skin slightly moist. To apply to face, spray on hair, then spread on face avoiding eyes and mouth. For chiggers and ticks use as directed above to tops of shoes and around openings in outer clothing. Will not damage common fabrics, nor poison or injure. May stain some fine fabrics and damage some artificial fabrics.

CAUTION Do not spray on face as eye contact will be injurious. May cause skin reaction in face when contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Hold nozzle at prolonged exposure to sun may cause bursting. Do not throw in fire or incinerator. KEEP OUT OF CHILD REACH.
