**DEODORIZES, CLEANS AND DISINFECTS DISHES, GLASSWARE, ENAMELWARE, PORCELAIN, MARBLE, DAIRY AND POULTRY EQUIPMENT.**

**X-O-X** when used to disinfect, deodorize, or remove stains from bathtubs, showers, basins, refrigerators, sinks, drainboards, tiling, windows and linoleum should follow hot suds washing with solution of 2 tablespoons **X-O-X** added to each quart of warm water. Wash well and rinse with clear water. Will not harm plumbing or septic tanks. **X-O-X** bleaches and deodorizes, so wash out your dish towels, dish cloths in sudsy water containing 1 tablespoon of **X-O-X** per gallon of water and you will have white, sweet towels always.

Garbage cans, ice boxes, and food storage compartments will be left clean and sanitized by washing with hot sudsy water and adding one cup of **X-O-X** to each 3 gallons of wash water.

**HOSPITALS AND SICK ROOMS:** Sick room utensils and hospital equipment should be submerged in water containing 1 cup **X-O-X** to 3 gallons water for 5 minutes. Rinse.

**SCHOOLS:** Mop all floors clean where students appear barefooted; dressing rooms, showers, swimming pools with soap and water containing 1 cup **X-O-X** to each quart water.
