

## **FOR A CLEANER HOUSE**

 IN BATHROOM AND KITCHEN CLEANING, use Clorox as directed to disinfect, deederize and remove stains from

SINKS TUBE/SHOWERS PORCELAIN
DRANNBOARDS FLOORS TILE/GLASS
STOVES BASINS PLASTIC
REFRIGERATORS WOODWORK GARBAGE CANS

WINGIL. Then WIPE with a solution of 14 cup Cloren per gallon of warm water. RIMEE. Repeat if necessary. (Frequent use on metals may cause discoloration.)

 TOLET BOWLS: Clean, flush. Pour in ½ cup Clorox; swish solution over inside. Let stand 10 minutes; flush. (Do not use toilet bowl cleaners with Clorox. See caution statement.) Septic tank operation is not affected by regular home and form use of Clorox.

## FOR A CLEANER WASH

TODAY'S PERMANENT PRESS FABRICS can be safely bleached and need Clorox for cleaning, stain removal and disinfecting you can't get from seep or detergent alone.

• FOR RESULAR WASH and permanent press use Clorox as directed below with any good soap or detergent.

Top-loading autometics (large) ... 1½ cup per load Top-loading automatics (standard) .1 cup per load Wringer-type washers ... . 1 cup per load Front-loading automatics ... ½ cup per load

Add Clorox whichever way is more convenient:

1. To wash water before laundry is put in or .

- If laundry is put in before wash water, dilute Clorox in quart of water and add after machine starts agitating and fabrics are thoroughly wet.
- 3. For weekers with automatic bleach dispensors, follow washer directions.
- STAM REMOVAL: Most stains will come out in a regular wash with Clarex and a good seep or detergent. For stubborn stains, pre-each entire item in solution of ½ cup Clorex per gallon of cool suday water 5 minutes. Rinse. Then wash with Clorex and seep or detergent.
- FOR MAND LAUNGERING: Use 1/6 cup Clorox per 2 gallons sudsy water. Mix well before wash is added.
- BIAPERS, BABY CLOTNES: Use Clorox in the laundry to destroy most gorms effectively. Clorox tends to reduce disper irritation. Follow directions under regular wash. Repeated use on 100% cotton flame retardent sleepwear may cause loss of flame retardancy.
- III BIAPER PAIL: Rinse dispers thoroughly then use 1/6 cup Clorox per 2 gallens water for edor-reducing pre-seek.
