FOR A CLEANER HOUSE

- IN BATHROOM AND KITCHEN CLEANING, use Clorox as directed to disinfect, deodorize and remove stains from
SINKS TUBS/SHOWERS PORCELAIN
DRAINBOARDS FLOORS TILE/GLASS
STOVES BASINS PLASTIC
REFRIGERATORS WOODWORK GARBAGE CANS
- WASH. Then WIPE with a solution of ½ cup Clorox per gallon of warm water. RINSE. Repeat if necessary. (Frequent use on metals may cause discoloration.)
- TOILET BOWLS: Clean, flush. Pour in ½ cup Clorox; swish solution over inside. Let stand 10 minutes; flush. (Do not use toilet bowl cleaners with Clorox. See caution statement.) Septic tank operation is not affected by regular home and farm use of Clorox.

FOR A CLEANER WASH

- TODAY'S PERMANENT PRESS FABRICS can be safely bleached and need Clorox for cleaning, stain removal and disinfecting you can't get from soap or detergent alone.
- FOR REGULAR WASH and permanent press use Clorox as directed below with any good soap or detergent.
Top-loading automatics (large) ... 1½ cup per load
Top-loading automatics (standard) ... 1 cup per load
Wringer-type washers ... 1 cup per load
Front-loading automatics ... ½ cup per load
- Add Clorox whichever way is more convenient:
1. To wash water before laundry is put in or ...
2. If laundry is put in before wash water, dilute Clorox in quart of water and add after machine starts agitating and fabrics are thoroughly wet.
- 3. For washers with automatic bleach dispensers, follow washer directions.
- STAIN REMOVAL: Most stains will come out in a regular wash with Clorox and a good soap or detergent. For stubborn stains, pre-soak entire item in solution of ½ cup Clorox per gallon of cool sudsy water 5 minutes. Rinse. Then wash with Clorox and soap or detergent.
- FOR HAND LAUNDERING: Use ½ cup Clorox per 2 gallons sudsy water. Mix well before wash is added.
- DIAPERS, BABY CLOTHES: Use Clorox in the laundry to destroy most germs effectively. Clorox tends to reduce diaper irritation. Follow directions under regular wash. Repeated use on 100% cotton flame retardant sleepwear may cause loss of flame retardancy.
- IN DIAPER PAIL: Rinse diapers thoroughly then use ½ cup Clorox per 2 gallons water for odor-reducing pre-soak.
