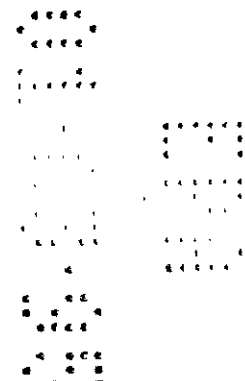
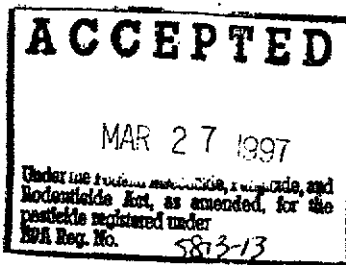

DIRECTIONS FOR HOUSEHOLD USE

Push up cap to open. After opening, point the top of the bottle down into the bowl. Squeeze gently to direct product into the bowl.

To disinfect toilet bowl: Thoroughly clean the bowl before disinfecting (remove excess dirt first in heavily soiled areas). Direct 4 oz of product onto the sides of the bowl and under the rim, letting it run down into the water. Brush entire bowl, especially under the rim, around the hard water ring and below the water. Let stand at least ten minutes before flushing.

Close cap securely after each use. Rinse brush in fresh water after use. Do not use bleach in the toilet bowl at the same time with Clorox Toilet Bowl Cleaner.

When used as directed, Clorox Toilet Bowl Cleaner will not harm white or colored bowls or harm plumbing. Never use on sinks, bathtubs, toilet lids or combined with chlorine or other chemicals.
