AND OCCASIONAL USE ONLY. Under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, for the pesticide registered under EPA Reg. No. 5813-14.

To Clean, Disinfect and Deodorize

1. Spray holding can 6 to 8 inches from surface to be cleaned.
2. Allow foam to penetrate dirt and soap scum.
3. Wipe clean. No scrubbing or rinsing needed (on stubborn spots, allow foam to remain on surface before wiping).
4. To insure that product can be sprayed when the container is nearly empty, point arrow on spray button to red mark on rim.

Kills *Staphylococcus aureus* (Staph) [ATCC 6538], *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* [ATCC 15442], *Streptococcus pyogenes* (Strep) [ATCC 9342], *Aspergillus niger* (Mildew) [ATCC 6275] and *Trichophyton interdigitale* (Athlete's Foot Fungus) (AFF) on hard, nonporous surfaces.

To Use as Mildewstat

To remove mold and mildew stains and odors and control their growth on hard non-porous surfaces, clean surface by following steps 1 through 4 above. Spray thoroughly with this product. Reapply if new growth appears.
