

- h. On the back panel, under item #4 change the statement "To remove mold ... from hard and porous surfaces" to "To remove mold ... from hard non-porous surfaces".
- 2. The revised Confidiential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated May 12, 1994 has been reviewed and found to be acceptable.
- 3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.


