The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to change "Tetrasodium EDTA and essential oils" from the active ingredients to the inert ingredients, is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. On the front panel, place the signal word "Danger" directly below the statement "keep Out of Reach of Children"
- b. Change the referral statement to read "See back panel for additional precautionary statements".
- d. Include a 10 minute contact time for the disinfection section.
- e. On the back panel, revise the precautionary statements to read:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
 Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

DANGER. Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eye, on skin, or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful If Swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

e. Change the heading "FIRST AID" TO "STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT"

f. Revise the storage and disposal section to read:

Storage and Disposal

Do not reuse empty container. Rinse container thoroughly and discard in trash.

h. On the back panel, under item #4 change the statement "To remove mold ... from hard and porous surfaces" to "To remove mold ... from hard non-porous surfaces".

2. The revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated May 12, 1994 has been reviewed and found to be acceptable.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

1. For normal cleaning, mix 1/4 cup to 1 gallon hot water. Use as directed. Clorox Cleaner will leave surfaces clean and shiny. No rinsing required.
2. For tough jobs--lipstick, scuff marks, tar, hardened grease, whitewall tires--use full strength, and wipe immediately. For sensitive skin, use rubber gloves as you would with other cleaning products.
3. To kill dangerous staph and strep germs and athlete's foot fungi on environmental surfaces, wipe with recommended solution (1/4 cup to 1 gallon water) until surface is thoroughly covered.
4. To remove mold and mildew and the odors they cause from hard and porous surfaces, clean surfaces with solution (1/4 cup to 1 gallon water) and reapply thoroughly with a damp cloth. Repeat application as necessary to maintain control.
