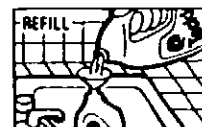
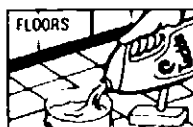
General Household Cleaning and Stain Removal

Apply Tackle with a damp sponge to surfaces such as counters, sinks, tubs, tile and kitchen appliances. Rinse or wipe clean. For sensitive skin, wear gloves.
Floors: Mop washable floors including no-wax floors, linoleum, vinyl and ceramic tile with solution of 1 cup Tackle per gallon of warm water. Rinse for the best shine.
Disinfecting Toilet Bowls: Flush toilet and add 3-4 cup of Tackle to bowl water. Brush to thoroughly wet all surfaces

including under the rim. Let stand 5 minutes before flushing.

Disinfecting Other Hard Non-Porous Surfaces

Apply full strength with cloth or sponge to wet surfaces thoroughly. Let stand 5 minutes. Kills staphylococcus, mildew and athlete's foot fungus. For heavy soil, pre-cleaning is required before disinfecting.
Economical Refill: For real economy and the convenience of a squeeze bottle, refill your 26 oz. size.



Precautionary Statements: Hazards to humans and domestic animals
