Dear Ms. Martinez:

The labeling for the product referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended (FIFRA) is acceptable subject to the comments/conditions listed below.

Conditions

1. The "Kills germs on hard, nonporous surfaces. . ." statement must be revised to read "Kills 99.9% of common household Germs*"
2. References to the American Red Cross and the required qualifying statements must be located together. The type size of the Red Cross symbol and/or other language such as the phrase "Dedicated to a Healthier World" cannot be any larger than that on the label accepted with this letter. Such references must not be given any greater prominence than any other described product feature.
3. All of the conditions set forth in the Agency letter to The Clorox Company on October 17, 2006 must be adhered to as outlined.

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

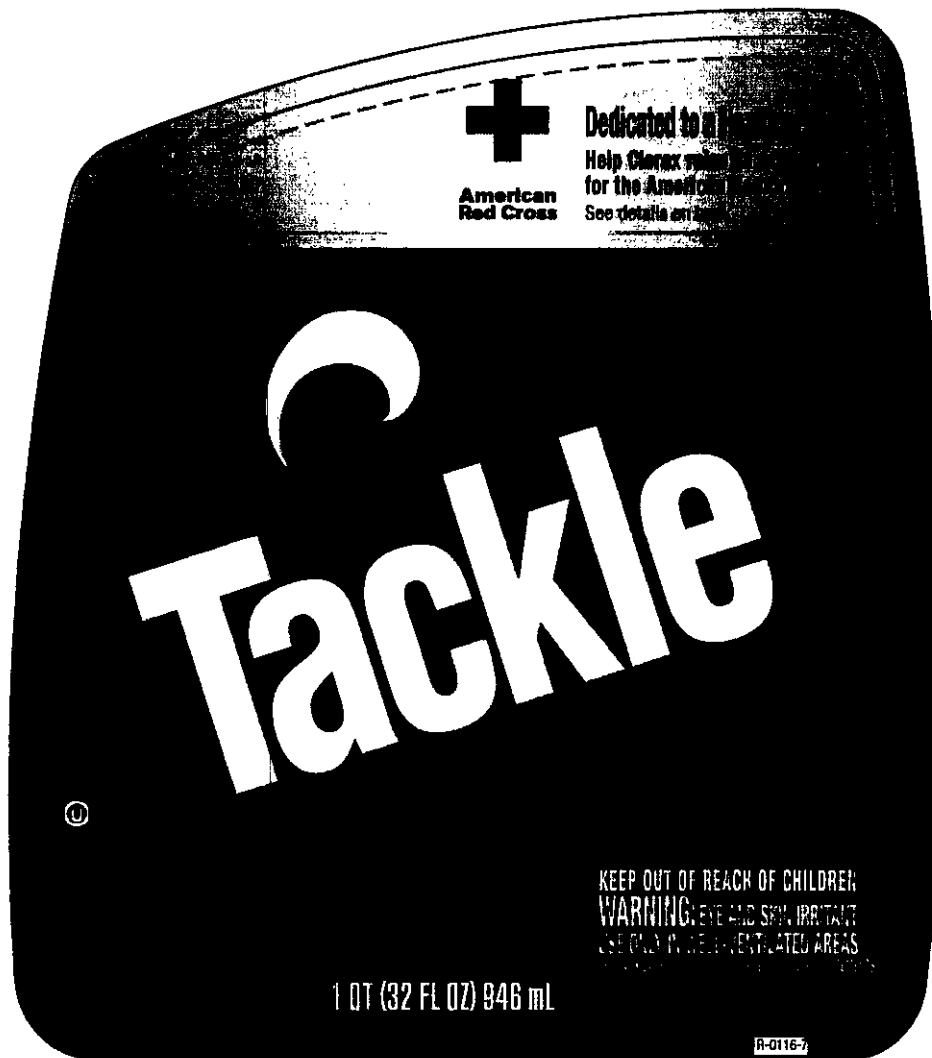
