For General Cleaning and Disinfecting

To Clean: Turn nozzle counterclockwise approximately 1/2 turn. Spray 6-8 inches from the surface. Spray with quick, full strokes until thoroughly wet. Wipe with a damp sponge or cloth. Rinse, if desired. For stubborn soils allow this product to soak on the soil for 2-5 minutes, wipe and rinse with water.

To Disinfect: Spray 6-8 inches from surfaces, until thoroughly wet. Surfaces must remain wet for 5 minutes. Allow to air dry or remove excess liquid with clean cloth, sponge, or mop. For heavy soil, pre-cleaning is required before disinfection. To control mold and mildew growth on hard, non-porous surfaces (Refer to Table 1), spray thoroughly. Reapply as new growth appears.

For Mildewstat—This product will effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew and the odor caused by them when applied by spraying 6-8 inches from surface. Allow the surface to remain wet for 5 minutes. Allow to air dry on surfaces. Repeat as new growth appears.

For Kitchen Cleaning—Spray this product directly on countertops, stoves, stove hoods, refrigerators, sinks and walls to remove the toughest grease, food spills, or burned on food and grease, then wipe with a damp sponge or cloth. Rinse, if desired.

For Bathroom Cleaning—Spray this product directly on your bathtub, sink or toilet to remove the toughest soap scum, hard water deposits, dirt and grease. For outside of the toilet bowl, follow general cleaning instructions.

For Floor Cleaning—This product effectively cleans all floors, including no wax floors. Dilute 1 cup this product per gallon of warm water. Rinse for best shine.
