Dear Ms. Lawson:

The Agency has reviewed your submission submitted in accordance with continuing registration under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, and determined the action acceptable with the following conditions:

- * Change "Let stand 5 minutes..." to "Let stand 10 minutes..."
- * Delete the sentence "Limited disinfectant against intestinal bacteria". This claim is not allowed because the label of a disinfectant which is effective against a specific major group of microorganisms only must specify the major group, not gram positive and gram negative.

In summary, your request to revise the precautionary text as proposed with your original submission is acceptable. A copy of your stamped accepted label is enclosed.



[TO DISINFECT:]

To disinfect hard, nonporous surfaces: Apply full strength -or- Mix 2 oz of this product with 1/2 cup of water. Rub on surface with damp sponge. Let stand 5 minutes before wiping clean. Rinse. For heavy soil, pre-clean surface before disinfecting:

Use on fiberglass [bath]tubs, sinks, shower stalls, [kitchen -and/or- bathroom] counters -or- countertops

To disinfect toilet bowl[s]: Flush toilet. Apply 4 oz to sides of bowl to kill gram-negative bacteria*. Brush to wet all surfaces including under rim. Let stand 10 minutes before flushing. Limited disinfectant against intestinal bacteria*.
