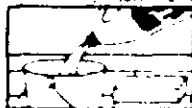

For best results, use on clean, dry surfaces. Apply liberally and wipe off with a damp cloth. For heavy mildew, soap scum, or soap buildup, use Tilex twice. For grout, use Tilex regularly to prevent mildew stains from reappearing. **Floors:** Mop washable floors including tile, vinyl, and ceramic tile with solution of 1 cup Tilex per gallon of warm water. Rinse for best shine. **To disinfect toilet bowls:** Flush toilet and add 1 cup Tilex to bowl. Water flush to thoroughly wet all surfaces, including under the rim. Let stand 5 minutes before flushing. **To disinfect other hard non-porous surfaces** such as walls, counters, sinks, etc., apply full strength to wet surfaces thoroughly. Let stand five minutes, and wipe with a sponge. Full strength stops mildew and athlete's foot fungus. For heavy soil, pre-cleaning is required before disinfecting.
