- Other minor label revisions


GENERAL COMMENTS

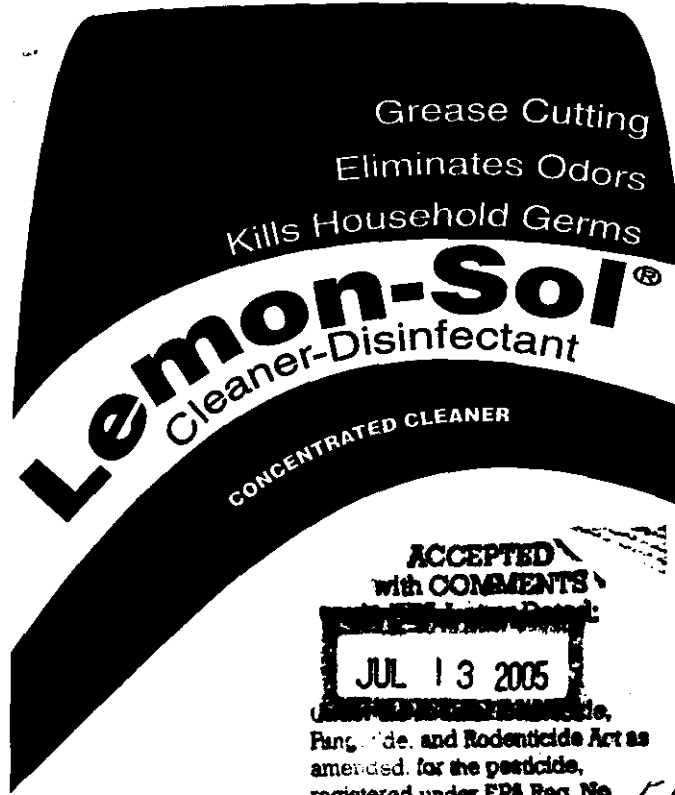

2. Use 1/4 cup in one gallon water.
Note: For effective disinfectant action, surfaces must be thoroughly wet with this product. Prepare a fresh solution daily; more frequently if the solution becomes diluted or soiled.
3. Spray, soak, dip, mop or use a mechanical spray device to wet all surfaces thoroughly. For really stubborn spots, wear rubber gloves and use direct from the bottle.
4. Let stand 10 minutes, and rinse [immediately].

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

Add 1/4 cup of this product to laundry with regular soap or detergent to make clothes fresh and odor free.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
