

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CLEANING AND DEODORIZING

FOR FLOORS, WALLS AND SIMILAR SURFACES: Dissolves old wax, greasy grime and film... even removes crayon marks. Use 1/4 cup per gallon of water. No rinsing required, except on rubber or asphalt tile. For extra tough jobs, use full strength and rinse immediately.

NO-WAX FLOORS: When used as directed, Pine-Sol Cleaner Disinfectant will not harm no wax floors. Use 1/4 cup per gallon of water, wash floor with mop or sponge and rinse.

BATHROOM: Cleans and deodorizes basins, tubs, and tiles. Use 1/4 cup per gallon of water, or full strength where odors are a problem.

TOILET BOWLS: Pour 2 1/2 oz in bowl and brush thoroughly, including under the rim.

GENERAL CLEANING: Add 1/4 cup per gallon of water. Usually no rinsing needed.

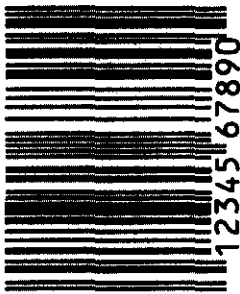
SPECIAL CLEANING AND DEODORIZING APPLICATIONS.

LAUNDRY: Rub in full strength on grease spots, collar and cuff stains or heavily soiled areas before washing. For extra cleaning and deodorizing power, add 1/2 cup to load along with your regular soap and detergent. Use only on white or colorfast fabrics.

GENERAL DISINFECTING: Kills household germs on hard, non-porous surfaces such as kitchen and bathroom floors, toilets, diaper pails and pet areas.
