


## PACKAGE OPENING INSTRUCTIONS

### ***Canister and Refill:***

**TO OPEN PACKAGE:** Flip open dispensing flap and remove lid by lifting upward. Pull up corner of CENTER SHEET, twist to a point and thread through small opening in lid. DO NOT PUSH FINGER THROUGH OPENING. Replace lid and PULL WIPE AT AN ANGLE; the next sheet pops up automatically. When finished, close flap to retain moisture. To open refill pack, tear at serrated edge. Remove wipes and place in canister.

**TO OPEN PACKAGE:** Lift flap on lid. Remove lid by lifting upward. Insert corner of CENTER SHEET through flap opening on lid. DO NOT PUSH FINGER THROUGH OPENING IN LID. Replace lid and PULL WIPE AT AN ANGLE. The next sheet pops up automatically. When finished, reseal by closing flap to retain moisture.

### ***Carton and Pouch:***

**TO OPEN PACKAGE:** Lift flap on carton. Open pouch by peeling back seal. Use wipes as directed. Reseal pouch after use.

***Pouch inside carton:***  
Pull tab to open, reseal after each use.

### ***Tub:***

**TO OPEN PACKAGE:** Flip open dispensing flap and remove lid by lifting upward. Place refill in tub. Open pouch by peeling back seal. Insert sheet through opening in lid. Replace lid and PULL WIPE OUT AT AN ANGLE. The next sheet pops up automatically. When finished, close lid flap to retain moisture. Lift flap on lid. Remove lid by lifting upward.

**TO CLEAN:** Wipe surface with wipe; let air-dry.

**TO DISINFECT\*:** Use to disinfect hard, nonporous surfaces; wipe surface to be disinfected. Wipe enough for treated surface to remain visibly wet for 4 minutes. Let surface dry. For highly soiled surfaces, clean excess dirt first.
