

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PACKAGE OPENING INSTRUCTIONS

Canister and Refill:

TO OPEN PACKAGE: Flip open dispensing flap and remove lid by lifting upward. Pull up corner of CENTER SHEET, twist to a point and thread through small opening in lid. DO NOT PUSH FINGER THROUGH OPENING. Replace lid and **PULL WIPE AT AN ANGLE**; the next sheet pops up automatically. When finished, close flap to retain moisture. To open refill pack, tear at serrated edge. Remove wipes and place in canister.

-or-

TO OPEN PACKAGE: Lift flap on lid. Remove lid by lifting upward. Insert corner of CENTER SHEET through flap opening on lid. DO NOT PUSH FINGER THROUGH OPENING IN LID. Replace lid and **PULL WIPE AT AN ANGLE**. The next sheet pops up automatically. When finished, reseal by closing flap to retain moisture.

Carton and Pouch:

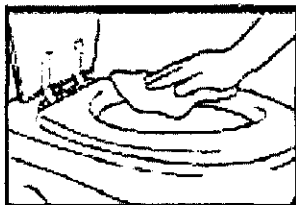
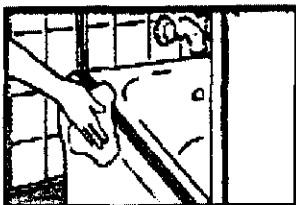
