Wood-Lastic Clear is for exterior use on above ground wood, it inhibits warping, shrinking, swelling, checking, cracking and water marking of the wood, it also protects and preserves wood against mold, mildew, rot, wood destroying fungi, mildew stain and attack by termites.

RECOMMENDED USES:

Wood-Lastic Clear is for above ground-us's enly. It can be used to protect, shingles, millwork, windows, outdoor furniture, poets, fences, declis, porch stape and house siding. Do not apply over bank, painted/varnished surfaces or pressure treated wood surfaces.

SURFACE PREPARATION:

New wood, millwork and other lumber products should be theroughly dry, well seasoned and free from bark before applying Wood-Lastic Clear. Do not use an wood into need for food, feed, potable water, livestock or dairy animals contact surfaces. May injure living plants during application. Cover plants to protect against direct contact.

APPLICATION: For millwork and other lumber products, dip three minutes for each inch of thickness or apply two or more saturating coats by brush or roller. Wood should be treated after all cuts are made and before use in the structure.

NOTE: Allow treated wood to dry thoroughly before painting, usually 48 hours under normal conditions.

COVERAGE:

100-300 square feet per gallon. Coverage will vary depending on the pcrosity of the wood and method of application.


