EASTERDAY SK-"45" is a disinfectant, cleaner, sanitizer, and fungicide compounded for institutional use such as hospitals, nursing homes, schools and industrial plants where housekeeping could be of prime importance in controlling the hazards of cross infection. Hard surface sanitation can help in this control and EASTERDAY SK-"45" can provide the assurance needed in this area, when used as directed. EASTERDAY SK-"45" can be used on surface not harmed by water when diluted according to directions.

DANGER

Keep out of Reach of Children. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid contamination of food. Remove and wash contaminated clothing.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use at 2 ounces per gallon. EASTERDAY SK-"45" will be effective against *Pseudomonifas, aeruginosa* PRD-10; at 10's level. This has been substantiated by the AOAC Use Dilution Confirmation Test. If used to sanitize equipment or other food contact items, limit the use dilution to 1/2 ounce per gallon equivalent to 200 ppm of quaternaries.

Before using EASTERDAY SK-"45" for disinfection a precleaning step is recommended for heavy soil or organic matter.

For best results, use EASTERDAY SK-"45" with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors, and other hard surfaces.

FUNGICIDAL PROPERTIES:

EASTERDAY SK-"45" at 2 oz/gal. will pass AOAC fungicidal test against pathogenic fungi.
