Statement of Practical Treatment

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucousal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

Directions for Use
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use: **TEXSAN NR** with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device. **TEXSAN NR** with a mechanical spray device on a surface must be sprayed until thoroughly wetted. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when the use solution becomes visibly dirty.

Disinfection in Hospitals, Nursing Homes and Other Health Care Institutions

For disinfecting floors, walls, countertops, bathing areas, lavatories, bedframes, tables, chairs, garbage pails and other hard non-porous surfaces.

Apply 4.5 oz. **TEXSAN NR** to 5 gallons of water. Apply to previously cleaned hard surface with mop or cloth.

At this use level, **TEXSAN NR** is effective against *Pseudomonas Aeruginosa*.

Disinfection in Institutions, Industry and Schools

For disinfecting floors, walls, bedframes, countertops, tables, chairs, garbage pails, bathroom fixtures and other hard non-porous surfaces.

Apply 4.5 oz. **TEXSAN NR** to 5 gallons of water. Apply to previously cleaned hard surface with mop or cloth.

At this use level, **TEXSAN NR** is effective against *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Salmonella typhimurium*.

Fungicide Activity

At this use level, **TEXSAN NR** is effective against *Trichophyton interdigitale* (athlete's foot fungus) on all hard surfaces.

Disinfection of Barber Tools

Prepared barber tools such as combs, brushes, razors, and straight razors can be disinfected by immersing in a 0.2% solution of **TEXSAN NR**.

Disinfection of Poultry Equipment, Animal Quarters and Barns

For the brooders, watering fountains, feeding equipment and other animal quarters such as stalls and pen areas, immerse in a 0.2% solution of **TEXSAN NR** after thorough cleaning. Apply a solution of 4.5 oz. **TEXSAN NR** to 5 gallons of water with a mop, cloth or brush. Surfaces should be immersed in this solution.

For the disinfection of poultry, other animals and their feet, they must be removed from the premises. This includes emptying all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering equipment. Remove all manure and droppings from floors, walls and other surfaces and clean or hosed off by poultry maintenance men.

After disinfection, ventilate brooder areas and other animal quarters. Do not use poultry or other animals or equipment until treatment has been finished, get clean water.

All treated equipment that will contact feed or drinking water should be rinsed with potable water before reuse.

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
