Dairy, Beverage, Food Processing, Strainers, Mixing Machine Parts, etc.

A. Clean equipment immediately after use.

1. Rinse - pre-scrape, required to remove soil - with clean water.
2. Wash - with the recommended solution.
3. Rinse - with clean water.
4. Air dry - protect from rust.

B. Sanitize immediately after use.

For utensils, pipel, etc. Sanitize by immersing in 2 gallons of water with 1 oz. (2 table spoons) of ACIDISAN A. Test periodically. Wash with clean water. Drain completely and dry.

For equipment that circulate, such as pressure spray units, etc. in 2 gallons of water add 1 oz. of ACIDISAN A. Cover all food contact surfaces. Drain for 30 seconds. Drain dry.
