GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Sheen Foliage Spray is designed to control most fungus diseases infecting flower gardens. Each packet makes 1 gallon of spray fungicide. Ideal for use with Black Leaf 40, or other standard insecticides. Excellent protection when used alone. Begin application when diseases threaten.

Mix the contents of each envelope in 1 gallon of water (or insecticide spray mixture) and spray foliage thoroughly every 7 to 10 days, to control the following diseases.

ROSES:

Black Spot

AZALEAS, CAMELLIAS:

Petal Blight (Spray petals twice every 7 days)

CARNATIONS,

CHRYSANTHEMUMS,

HOLLYHOCKS,

SNAPDRAGONS:

Rust, Leaf Spot, Anthracnose.

DAHLIAS:

Leaf Spot, Botrytis Blight

GLADIOLI:

Botrytis Blight, Curvularia, Stemphylium

TOMATOES:

Early and Late Blight, Anthracnose, Septoria, phylum and Septoria Leaf Spots, Gledosporium Grey Mold.
