

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- 1 lb. Tedion Pressure-Fumigator will effectively control Red Spider Mites on roses, carnations, chrysanthemums and many other greenhouse ornamentals; up to 30,000 cu. ft.
- 1. Seal the greenhouse by closing all doors, ventilators, windows and other entrances to be sure no one will enter greenhouse during fumigation.
- 2. Fumigate only when plants and foliage are dry, and have inside temperature between 70°F and 85°F. The walks may be wet down since they will cause the vapor to come closer to the plants.
- 3. Shake can vigorously to loosen the powder. Punch both circled eyelets completely, using a beer can type opener to make the opening. Place the cans uniformly spaced on the walks so that vapors will be distributed evenly to the plants.
- 4. Light the igniter and tilt can to throw powder away from one eyelet and insert burning igniter entirely inside the can. Prompt ignition will result. Place can on floor with holes pointed the length of the walk. Proceed quickly to the next can and proceed until all cans are ignited.
- 5. During fumigation keep greenhouse tightly closed for one hour. After fumigation ventilate the greenhouse thoroughly before resuming work.
- 6. For best results cans should be stored at room temperature.



During periods when Red Spider Mites are causing damage, Tedion fumigations should be repeated weekly. Tedion may result in leaf drop on White Butterfly and Cinderella roses. Inhalation of smoke and vapors is harmful. Do not get in eyes or on skin or clothing. Avoid using where fish or aquatic life are present. Avoid contamination of food or food stuffs.
