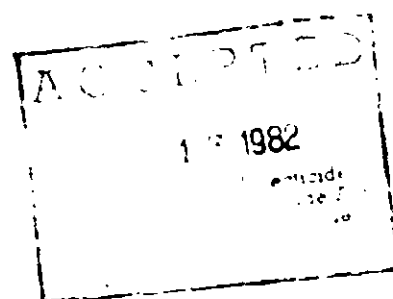

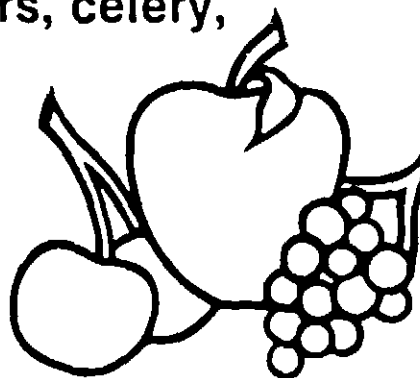

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed.

TRI BASIC BORDEAUX POWDER should be used in accordance with recommendations of State or Federal Authorities for basic copper sulfate compounds containing the equivalent of 12.75% metallic copper. The following general directions are supplied by us gratuitously and are believed to be reliable but are not a warranty.

FOR USE ON	CONTROLS THESE DISEASES OR FUNGI	AMOUNT OF DOSAGE REQUIRED HOW MUCH	WHEN
FRUITS			
Sour Cherries	Brown rot Leaf Spot	4 tablespoons plus 2 tablespoons of hydrated spray lime per gallon of water	Start to apply as soon as leaves appear and repeat every 10 days
Grapes	Black rot Downy mildew	7 tablespoons with 4 tablespoons of hydrated spray lime per gallon of water	Start to apply at end of dormant season every 10 to 14 days
Apples	Bitter rot Blotch Scab	3 tablespoons with 2 tablespoons of hydrated spray lime per gallon of water	After leaves open repeat every 7 to 10 days
Gooseberries Currants	Anthrax Leaf spot	4 1/2 tablespoons with 2 1/2 tablespoons of hydrated spray lime per gallon of water	After leaves open and leaves through
Peaches Nectarines	Leaf Curl Brown Rot Peach Blight (Shot Hole)	4 tablespoons per gallon of water	5 to 6 sprays for Brown Rot and Peach Blight. Start the spray 10 to 15 days before buds break and repeat after bud break. Do not spray after bud break or after trees are in full leaf as injury may occur.
Note: To control Leaf Curl, spray must be made before the foliage turns green. As a dormant spray for Leaf Curl and Peach Blight apply Nov. 15 to Dec. 15 when leaves begin. Caution: Over spraying may cause injury to tender foliage.			
VEGETABLES			
Potatoes	Early blight Late blight	14 tablespoons per gallon of water	Apply when plants are 4 to 6 inches high. Repeat every 10 to 14 days
Tomatoes	Anthrax Early blight Late blight	14 tablespoons per gallon of water	When plants first set out repeat every 10 to 14 days
Cantaloupes Cucumbers Squash Watermelons	Angular leaf spot and scab Anthrax Downy mildew	7.9 tablespoons per gallon of water	As soon as plants begin to vine repeat every 7 days
Celery	Early blight Late blight	11 to 14 tablespoons per gallon of water	Apply in seed bed every 7 to 10 days
TREES			
Linden Oak Maple Elm	Anthrax Leaf spot Elm leaf curl	6.7 tablespoons per gallon of water	Spray as leaves appear. Repeat every 2 to 3 weeks

Depending on use this package will make 25 to 50 gallons of spray.

TRI BASIC BORDEAUX POWDER is not recommended for early application on varieties of apples susceptible to copper russeting.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Store in a dry, cool area. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

This container sold by weight and not by volume. If it does not appear full when opened, it is because contents settled during shipping and handling.
