The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following label changes:

a) In the Directions for Use, delete the sentence "Repeat as necessary, generally at 5 to 7 day intervals."

b) In the Directions for Use, delete the sentence "Do not apply more than 3 lbs. active ingredient per acre." This sentence is not appropriate for a homeowner product.

c) Per the Agency letter dated 10/1/96, the Directions for Use on pets should read as follows:

"DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON PETS: Use product only outside or in a wellventilated area. Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, dust entire animal, avoiding pet's eyes, nose, mouth and genital areas. Rub or brush pet's hair to work dust down to the skin. This product should not be applied by children. Do not use on pregnant dogs. Do not use on kittens or puppies under 12 weeks of age. Dust bedding and doghouse soing a shaker can or other dust applicator."

2. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
