Ornamentals in Garden Roses Carnations Evergreens Azaleas Rhododendrons Shade trees	Aphids, Bagworms, Mealy bugs, Japanese beetles, Plant bugs, Red spider mite, Lace bugs, Tent caterpillars, Taxus weevil, Leaf-miners, Juniper webworms, Certain Scale scawlers.	Mix 1 tablespoonful in 1 gallon of water. Mix carefully and agitate during use. Cover plant surfaces being certain to contact as many insects as possible. Use 4 tablespoonsful per gallon on Japanese Beetles and Bagworms. Apply as soon as growth appears and repeat spray every 2 weeks until mid-summer. Spray once a month after mid-summer.
Lawns	Ants, Mosquitos, Flies.	Use 1 tablespoonful of Black Leaf Garden & Evergreen Spray to each gallon of water. Use 1 gallon of spray per 35 sq. ft. of area.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise the following in the "HAZARDS TO HUMANS..." section:

"Wash thoroughly after using and before eating or smoking."

(Underscore added to indicate revision; do not reproduce underscore on labeling.)

2. Revise the text of your "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" section to read as follows:

"This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Birds and other wildlife feeding in treated areas may be killed. Keep out of any body of water. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas to be treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues remaining on the treated area. Do not apply when bees are actively visiting vegetation blooming in the treatment area. Applications should be timed to provide the maximum possible interval between treatment and the next period of bee activity."

3. Add the heading "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" to immediately precede the Storage and Disposal directions.
4. Immediately following the heading "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" insert the following:

"It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."

- 5. Add the following at the beginning of the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" (above the chart):

"Do not allow children to handle or apply this product. Keep children and pets out of treated area until spray has dried."

- 6. A STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT must be added to the labeling. We suggest the following statement, however, if your toxicological data suggests otherwise, please submit a draft STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT for prior approval:

"STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If swallowed- Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- If inhaled- Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- If on skin- Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If in eyes- Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

Note to Physician- Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally."

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until ~~1984~~ 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
