

## HOW TO APPLY ON LAWNS

Read entire label before using. This can treats up to 40 sq. feet.

Spray uniformly over measured area to be treated, wetting grass thoroughly.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**Use can in inverted position only**

REMOVE COVER CAP, POINT CAN DOWNWARD AT LAWN AND PRESS LEVER TO SPRAY. APPLY CONTENTS OF CAN EVENLY OVER AREAS INDICATED BELOW. COVERED AREA WILL BE IDENTIFIED BY COLORED FOAM WHICH DISAPPEARS IN SEVERAL MINUTES.

**YOUNG CRAB GRASS:** (Late Spring or Early Summer.) Apply contents of can evenly over 40 sq. feet of lawn. Make 2 more applications, 7 days apart. Repeat, if necessary, to control new growth later in the season.

**BRANCHED CRAB GRASS:** Apply contents of can evenly over 30 sq. feet of lawn. Make 2 more applications, 7 days apart.

**IMPORTANT:** Soil should be moist before treating. During dry spells water grass well before treating. Accurate applications of the proper amount is important for effective control.

**NOTE:** This product kills Crab Grass without injury to Kentucky Blue, Meric. Blue, Zoysia, and Bermuda grasse when used as recommended. Temporary discoloration may occur on fescue and bent grass. Do not use on St. Augustine or Centipede lawns. On newly-seeded lawns apply only after the third mowing.

RESULTS

1. Crab Grass is killed and does not regrow.

2. Other lawn grasses are not injured.

3. Lawn is kept beautiful.

4. No need to mow frequently.

5. No need to water frequently.

6. No need to fertilize frequently.

7. No need to spray frequently.

8. No need to use other lawn care products.

9. No need to worry about crab grass.

10. No need to worry about other lawn care products.
