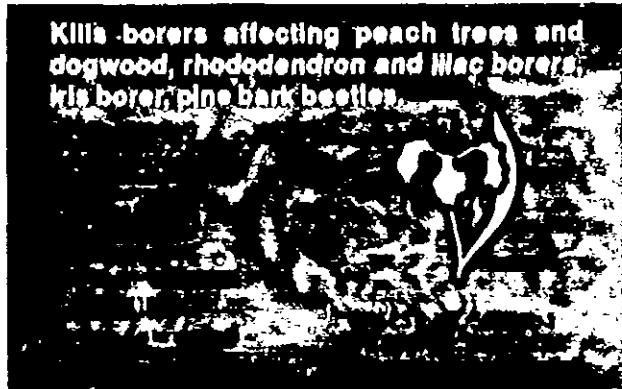


DRAFT LABELING

Black Leaf Borer Spray

Contains lindane

Kills borers affecting peach trees and dogwood, rhododendron and lilac borer, his borer, pine bark beetles.



CONTROLLED PLANTS	TO USE	APPLICATION
Apple	Apply to leaves and fruit.	Destroy old leaves in early spring. Apply in May.
Peach	Apply to leaves and fruit.	Do not apply directly to fruit. Apply to leaves and fruit.
Rhododendron	Apply to leaves and fruit.	Do not apply directly to fruit. Apply to leaves and fruit.
Lilac	Apply to leaves and fruit.	Do not apply directly to fruit. Apply to leaves and fruit.
Pine	Apply to leaves and fruit.	Do not apply directly to fruit. Apply to leaves and fruit.

DISPOSAL
Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash collection.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
IF SWALLOWED: Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Do not administer Epinephrine. Get medical attention immediately.
IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration if indicated.
IF ON SKIN: Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.
IF IN EYES: Rinse eyes for at least 15 minutes with water and call a physician immediately.

Subject: Amendment - Comply with Lindane Intent to Cancel
Black Leaf Borer Spray
EPA Registration No. 5887-54
Application Dated November 29, 1983

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. We suggest that you revise the "If swallowed" portion of the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows. If your toxicological data indicate otherwise, submit draft language for our review.

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

2. Also add the following note to physician statement immediately following the statement of practical treatment.

Note to Physician - Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally.

3. According to our records, use of lindane on apple and peach trees requires a 60 day pre-harvest interval regardless of how it is applied. Therefore, add this restriction to the label. Note that this restriction does not apply to cherry trees, so you may wish to separate these use sites.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

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A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until *June 30*, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
