

## Lawn Weed Killer

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**BLACK LEAF LAWN WEED KILLER** contains both 2,4-D and Dicamba for effective control of a broad range of weeds infesting lawns. Do not use on centipede grass, dichondra, fescue, lawns or turf where desirable bent grass or clovers are present. Newly seeded lawns may be treated after they have been mowed the second time. To resod small areas in treated lawns, wait at least 3 weeks after spraying. A good rain or deep watering should occur during this period.

**BLACK LEAF LAWN WEED KILLER** is effective for the control of dandelion, chicory, clover, dock, dog fennel, English daisy, Frenchweed, knotweed erect, knotweed prostrate, ground ivy, hawkweed, heat-seal, henbit, lambsquarters, mallow, morning glory, chickweed, mouse-ear, common-stitchwort, mustard, oxalis, pennywort, pepperglass, pigweed, plantain, poison ivy, poison oak, Canada thistle, burdock, jimson weed, lamb's-quarters, ragweed, smartweed, sheep sorrel, spotted spurge, wild aster, wild carrot, winged garlic, wild onion, wild radish, wood sorrel, and many other broadleaf weeds.

**LAWN WEEDS** To kill dandelion, wild onion, pennywort, plantain, heat-seal and similar weeds, use 8 ounces in 6 gallons of water and apply with sprayer or sprinkling can to 2,500 square feet of lawn. (For smaller areas use 2 teaspoonsful in 2 quarts of water applied to 100 square feet.) For larger areas use 1 gallon in 50 gallons of water to 1 acre.

Do not apply to areas underlaid by roots of desirable tree and shrubs. To kill weeds such as thistles, bindweed, dock and ragweed, use 8 ounces in 6 gallons of water (or 2 teaspoonsful in 2 quarts of water) and apply directly to plants, wetting them thoroughly. Repeat as necessary. For larger areas use 1 gallon in 50 gallons of water.

To kill undesirable plants such as poison ivy and poison oak, use 8 teaspoonsful in 2 quarts of water or 1 gallon in 1 1/2 gallons of water and drench plants when they are fully leaved. Repeat in about 4 weeks if necessary. Certain hard-to-kill weeds such as poison ivy, poison oak, English daisy may require a fall application.

**IMPORTANT** Avoid drift of spray (coarse sprays are less likely to drift) on vegetables, flowers, ornamental shrubs, trees and other desirable crop plants. Do not pour solution used to clean sprayer near desirable plants.
