STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Get medical attention immediately.

IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air if effects occur, and call physician.

IF ON SKIN: Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

To Physician—Atropine sulfate is antidotal.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Flammable: Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not smoke while using. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F. may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator. Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, rubber and asphalt surfaces of patios, roofs, floors, etc.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CONTROL OF WASPS AND HORNETS: Apply after dark when all of the insects have returned to the nest. Aim valve opening at nest and depress button, soaking the nest with the spray. Repeat as necessary. Avoid wetting vegetation with this spray, as it will be damaged. Do not use as a space spray.

OTHER USES—OUTDOORS ONLY: For control of ants, clover mites, crickets, earwigs, fleas, millipedes, sowbugs and brown dog ticks. Spray infested areas thoroughly including outside frames, doors, window frames, foundations, patios or other places where insects may enter or harbour. For ants, spray hills and runways. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation. Do not use as a space spray.

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

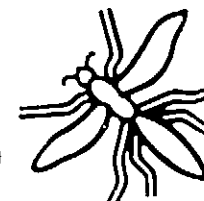
