HOW TO MIX AND APPLY

Step 1. Determine size of spraying job. For lawns and vegetables measure the area to be sprayed. For all other applications apply as a thorough cover spray. Make applications when insects first appear.
Step 2. Use clean sprayer. Carefully measure and mix the amount of Diazinon[®] and water as suggested in the chart.
Step 3. Spray as directed in rate chart. Use coarse drenching sprays for lawns, soil and other surface applications. Use medium-fine mist sprays for trees and plants. Thorough coverage is important. Flush sprayer with clean water after each use.
