Snails and slugs are night feeders that prefer cool, damp places; such as found in gardens, under flower pots, boards, hedges and bushes. Their presence can be detected by their shiny mucous-like trail. Follow directions and use with care. Pellets should be scattered and not piled.

To open: Push down and turn the cap.

To close: Replace cap and close tightly.

Water infested areas thoroughly. Broadcast directly on lawn or turf. Do not water treated areas for 48 hours.

Slugs & Snails

1 lb. to cover 1,500 sq. ft. of infested areas.

Ornamentals

Ground cover

Water infested areas thoroughly. Sprinkle SLUG AND SNAIL KILLER around edges and borders of flower beds and ground cover. Sprinkle along the ground at the base of walls or fences as well as shaded areas. Do not water for 48 hours.

Ants, chinch bugs, earwigs, millipedes, sod webworms, sowbugs

Spread equivalent of 1 lb. of materials to 250 sq. ft. of infested area.

Fruits

Apples, Avocados, Blackberries, Cherries, Citrus, Grapes, Peaches, Plums, Strawberries

Water infested areas thoroughly. Apply to the soil surface around the plants. Do not apply to foliage or other plant parts. Do not contaminate edible parts. Do not water for 48 hours.

Vegetables

Asparagus, Beans, Beets, Cabbage, Carrots, Corn, Cucumber, Eggplant, Lettuce, Melons, Onions, Peas, Peppers, Potatoes, Radishes, Spinach, Squash, Tomatoes, Turnips

STORAGE & DISPOSAL
