

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**  
**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION**

Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. In case of contact immediately flush eyes and skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Washable / Laundered. Cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of eating utensils and food preparation surfaces. Remove pets, birds and cover fish exposures before spraying. Do not use on edible crops.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**  
Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 120° F. may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**General Classification**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

**INDOOR PESTS—KIDS, Household, Mosquitoes and Gnats:** Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward. Direct spray sheet to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

**KIDS, Clothing Insects:** Roaches, cockroaches, grain moths, sawflies, silverfish, spiders and centipedes. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks under refrigerators, humidifiers, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary. Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

**OUTDOORS—TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS:** Reduce mosquitoes, gnats (midges), houseflies, deer flies, horse flies and flying insects (moths) by spraying their resting areas. Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 10 to 24 inches from shrubs, bushes and prairie areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of from 1 to 3 pounds per cubic yard of space, while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

**OUTDOORS—TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS:** To kill aphids, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, leafhoppers, two spotted mites, plant bugs, spittlebugs and Japanese beetles on smaller rhododendrons, pines, spruce, hemlock, spruce, juniper, pine, mimosas, leyland, viburnum, euonymus, oaks, maples, locust, forsythia and willow, and mesemis whiteworm larvae on mimosas. Spray directly on insects. Hold container 10 inches from the infested plants. Spray in short spray bursts of one to three seconds or spray at the rate of one liter (one quart) of product per second. Direct spray to all sides covering foliage until slightly moist. Avoid heavy spray. Reapply if necessary to obtain control.

Spray pines, arborvitae, junipers, magnolias, arborvitae, chrysanthemums, nasturtiums, daisy geraniums, marigolds, daphne, hollyhocks, myrtle, lobelia, Queen Anne's lace and broad leaf acacia for control of aphids, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, leafhoppers, plant bugs, spittlebugs and Japanese beetles. Spray as directed above.

**USE WITH CAUTION** on azaleas, honeys, roses, including hybrid tea roses, flowering quince, ash and camellias. These plants may be subject to leaf or flower burn under certain conditions of use.

For adult whiteflies and two spotted mites be sure to direct spray to contact these pests. Thoroughly coat the infested area. Use several repeat applications at two day intervals if necessary.

**HARMFUL PESTS—ON OR ENTERING BUILDINGS**

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Spiders: Apply spray directly to webs and harbors that enter buildings.

Spiders: Direct short bursts of spray on spiders and repeat as necessary.

Earrings: Spray directly on earrings in crevices and other hiding places on outdoor porches, patio floor and driveway entrances.

**DISPOSAL**

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
