PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO MAN AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. In case of contact immediately flush eyes and skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Harmful if swallowed. Cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of nesting animals and food preparation surfaces. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not eat on treated areas.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contains under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F. may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

HOUSEHOLD PESTS—Kills Houseflies, Mosquitoes and Spiders: Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle against insect. Direct spray into all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

Kills Crawling Insects—Roaches, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, silverfish, spiders and centipedes: Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, bookshelves, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary. Note: Spray walls, seats and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS—TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS—Repels mosquitoes, gnats (midges), houseflies, deer flies, horse flies and biting midges (biters) by spraying their resting areas. Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 18 to 24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of from 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space, while moving away from the treated area. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS—TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS—Kills aphids, exposed thrips, leafhoppers, two-spotted mites, plant bugs, Japanese beetles on smaller rhododendrons, plants, spruce, hemlock, spruce, dogwood, palm, mimosa, lily, viburnum, clematis, oak, maple, locust, myrtle and others. Kills minute weevil larvae on mimosa. Spray directly on insects.

Kills aphids, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, leafhoppers, two-spotted mites, plant bugs, spittlebugs and Japanese beetles on peonies, iris, lilies, anemones, ageratum, chrysanthemum, aster, geranium, daisy, geranium, marigold, daphne, tulip, hyacinth, queen crape, butterfly azalea.
Hold container 18 inches from the infested plant. Spray in short bursts of one to three seconds, or spray at a rate of one slower foot of growth per second. Direct spray to all sides, covering foliage until slightly moist. Avoid heavy wetting. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

USE WITH CAUTION on anemone, impatiens, rose, including hybrid tea roses, flowering quince, ash and camellia. These plants may be subject to leaf or flower burn under certain conditions of use. For adult whiteflies and two-spotted mites be sure to direct spray to protect these pests. Thoroughly cover the infested area. Use several repeat applications at two day intervals if necessary.

PROTECT SENSITIVE PLANTS—Kills aphids, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, two-spotted mites on African violet, philodendron, gossypium, begonia, calceol. Spray as directed above. Leave the sprayed area when done. Ants, and weevils are other treatment is completed.

HOUSEHOLD PESTS—ON OR EXTERIOR BUILDINGS
Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Wasps and hornets: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, remaining as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. Spray directly on stinging wasps and hornets that enter buildings.

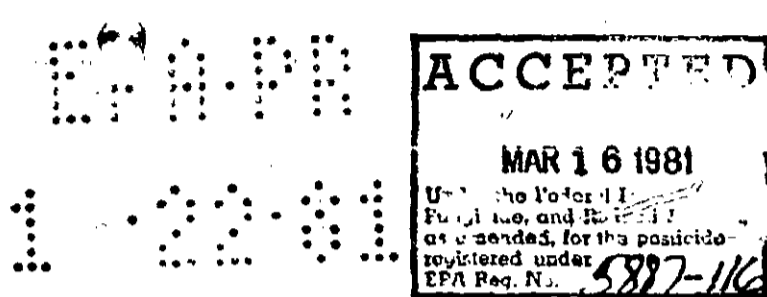
Spiders: Direct short bursts of spray on spiders and repeat as necessary.
Earwigs: Spray directly on earwigs in crevices and other hiding places on outdoor patios, porches and driveway entrances.
