PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. In case of contact immediately flush eyes and skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Wash if swallowed. Cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food preparation surfaces. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not use on edible crops.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw containers into fire or incinerator.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

HOUSEHOLD PESTS: Kills Houseflies, Mosquitoes and Gnats. Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward. Direct spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist. Don't leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

ANTS: Crawling insects: Roaches, earwigs, grass mites, sowbugs, silverfish spiders and centipedes. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, under pipes, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary. **ANTS:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS: Reduce mosquitoes, gnats, chiggers, houseflies, deer flies, horse flies and flying daddy longlegs by spraying their resting areas. Follow directions listed above. Hold container 18 to 24 inches from shrub, bushes and grass areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of about 1 to 3 seconds per cubic foot of space, while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS: Kills aphids, exposed thrips, earwigs, two spotted mites, plant bugs, Japanese beetles or smaller rhododendron gnats, spruce hemlock spruce diamond borer, tomato thrips, viburnum budworm, budworm, apple maggot, locust borer, and other tree and shrub borers. Spray directly on insects.

ANTS: Kills exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, earwigs, two spotted mites, plant bugs, gall midges and Japanese beetles on potted and indoor shrubs, agave, chrysanthemum, cyclamen, hydrangea, azalea, geranium, marigold, daphne, lily-of-the-valley, ivy, spider, clematis, and other plants.

Hold container 18 inches from the infested plants. Spray in short bursts of one to three seconds or spray a fan of one linear foot of growth per second. Direct spray to all sides, covering foliage and soil. Avoid heavy wetting. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

USE WITH CAUTION on azaleas, hollyhocks, roses, including hybrid tea roses, flowering dogwood, ash and camellias. These plants may be subject to leaf or flower burn under certain conditions of use. For adult whiteflies and two spotted mites be sure to direct spray to contact these pests. Thoroughly cover the infested area. Use several repeat applications at two day intervals if necessary.

PROTECT HOUSE PLANTS: Kills aphids, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, two spotted mites, earwigs, mites, plant bugs, Japanese beetles, geranium, begonia, carnation. Spray as directed above. Leave the sprayer a few inches above and ventilate area after treatment is completed.

HUMAN PESTS - ON OR ENTERING BUILDINGS

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Wasps and Hornets: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray directly into nesting and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. Spray directly on wasps and hornets that enter buildings.

Spiders: Direct short bursts of spray on spiders and repeat as necessary.

Earwigs: Spray directly on earwigs in cracks and other hiding places on outdoor porches, patios, lawns and nearby buildings.
