PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Rinse contact with eyes, skin or clothing. In case of contact immediately flush eyes and skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Remove if soothened. Cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food preparation surfaces. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not use on edible crops.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting. Never throw container near fire or incinerator.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to sell this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

INDOOR PESTS - Kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes and Gnats. Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward. Direct spray mist to all parts of the room, especially corners and other tight sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist. Then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

Adult Crawling insects. Roaches, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, silverfish, spiders and centipedes. Spray thorough holes hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and stabs, underneath refrigerators, baseboards and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary. Ants. Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - TO REDUCE INFESTATION FROM FLYING INSECTS. Reduce mosquitoes, gnats, flies, horse flies, deer flies and flying insects outdoors by spraying their resting areas. Follow instructions listed above. Hold container 10 to 20 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow spraying motion at the rate of from 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS. Kill aphids, spotted thrips, earwigs, two-spotted mites, plant bugs, Japanese beetles, spider mites, red spider mites, white fly, caterpillars, hornworm larvae or moths. Spray directly on insects.

Adult aphids, spotted thrips, adult whiteflies, leafhoppers, two-spotted mites, plant bugs, spittlebugs and Japanese beetles on flowers, fruit trees, shrubs, evergreen, azaleas, chrysanthemums, hibiscus, dianthus, geraniums, marigolds, daffodils, tulips, lilies, garden sage, broadleaf weeds.

Hold container 10 inches from the infested plants. Spray on plant parts at one to three seconds of spray at a rate of one quart per second. Direct spray to all sides, covering foliage until a light mist is formed. Avoid heavy wetting. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

USE WITH CAUTION ON DECIDUOUS TREES - including hybrid tea roses, flowering quince, ash and camellias. These plants may be subject to leaf or flower burn under certain conditions of use. For new plantings and two-spotted mites be sure to direct spray to contact these pests. Thoroughly cover the treated area. Use several repeat applications at two day intervals if necessary.

PROTECT HOUSE PLANTS. Kill aphids, spotted thrips, adult whiteflies, two-spotted mites on African violets, petunias, geraniums, begonias, caladium. Spray as directed above. Leave the sprayer open when done. Edges and underside area after treatment is completed.

UNSAFETY PESTS - ON OR NEARINING BIRDS, BIRDS

Adult. Spray from nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Wasps and hornets. Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray, debris and hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. Spray & wash off trash cans and barrels near outer buildings.

Spiders. Direct short bursts of spray on spiders and repeat as necessary.

Earwigs. Spray directly on earwigs in crevices and other hiding places on outdoor porches, patio, roof and eaves, eaves.

Do not pour empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
