HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not use near fishbowls or aquaris. Do not apply directly to water.

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Read entire label and apply as directed. Shake well before using. This insecticide may be used outdoors in gardens or in greenhouses throughout the growing season or as a pre-harvest treatment when other insecticides are prohibited due to residue restrictions and use limitations.

For best results, use throughout the growing season to prevent buildup of insect populations. Hold can in an upright position while spraying. Spray plants from a distance of 1½ to 2 feet using short bursts (one second). To prevent injury to plants, avoid visibly wetting the foliage.

Apply in the early morning or late evening when the air is still, treating all foliage with particular attention to the undersides of the leaves. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat applications at 7 to 10 day intervals, after heavy rains, or as reinfestation occurs.

USE ON: asparagus, beans, broccoli, cabbage, brussels sprouts, cauliflower, celery, cranberries, cucumbers, melons, squash, eggplants, lettuce, mustard greens, kale, collards, turnips, peppers, potatoes, radishes, spinach, sweet corn and tomatoes.

TO CONTROL: asparagus beetles, aphids, leafhoppers, whiteflies, Mexican bean beetles, 12-spotted cucumber beetles, cabbage loopers, cross-striped cabbageworms, diamondback moth caterpillar, flea beetles, harlequin bugs, imported cabbageworms, stink bugs, green peach aphids, leaf-tiers, tireworms, leafhoppers, blister beetles, Colorado potato beetles, webworms, Japanese beetles.
