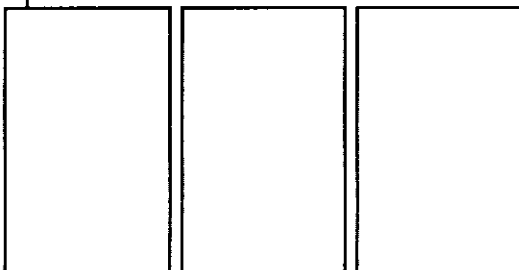

Gardener's Choice™ Plant Starter is especially designed to hasten the development of bareroot roses, non-bearing fruit trees and shade trees and benefits bedding plants, new seedlings and all trees and shrubs that have been moved to new locations. It helps plants become established quickly and insures vigorous growth.

The soil penetrant and wetting agent added, reduces the surface tension of soil and allows the material to gain easy access to root area where it uniformly spreads over the root surface bringing them the proper stimulant for renewed growth.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash hands thoroughly after handling. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before use.

HOW TO USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is concentrated and must be diluted before making applications. Mix one tablespoonful of this product into one gallon of water.

At time of transplanting, apply mixture to bare roots and soil thoroughly saturating the plant's root area. Plants will not be damaged if larger volumes of diluted solutions are used. Transplanted shrubs, trees, flowers, rooted cuttings, potted plants, and houseplants should be treated once a week until the plants are satisfactorily established. Apply mixture to soil around base of plant above root area. Subsequent monthly applications are recommended. Gardener's Choice™ Plant Starter is a root stimulant and should not be applied to the plant's foliage as a fertilizer or plant food.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate.

FIRST AID

Have the product container or label with you when calling poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.
