Dear Ms. Ratliff:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

• In the Precautionary Statements, make the following revisions:

Change: "May be harmful if swallowed" to "Harmful if Swallowed."

Add: "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."

Replace: "Change to clean clothing daily" with "Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."

In the Note to Physician, delete the statement: "Carbaryl is a moderate, reversible cholinesterase inhibitor." Revise the remaining text to read:

Carbaryl is an N-methyl carbamate acid ester that inhibits cholinesterase. Atropine is antidotal. Do not use 2-PAM, opiates, or cholinesterase inhibiting drugs.

Correct the typographical error in the heading "Hot Line Number."

• In the Directions for Use, General Recommendations, place a closed parentheses after sweet corn, fodder, ie. "...sweet corn (fodder)."

Do not apply within 14 days of harvest on field and pop corn (forage, silage) and 48 days of harvest (grain, fodder.)
