If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air and apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on Skin: Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.

If in Eyes: Rinse eyes with plenty of water and call a physician immediately.

Note to Physician: This product is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine. This product contains a petroleum distillate which may present an aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage may be indicated if product was taken internally.

## ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is highly toxic to birds, fish and other wildlife. Birds, especially waterfowl, feeding or drinking on treated, areas may be killed. Because of the migratory habits of Atlantic Coast waterfowl, do not apply this product to lawns in Nassan County, New York between November 1 and May 20. Do not exceed maximum permitted label rates. Rates above those recommended significantly increase potential hazards to birds and waterfowl. Avoid overlapping of sprays. If waterfowl, i.e. ducks, geese can be expected to enter


