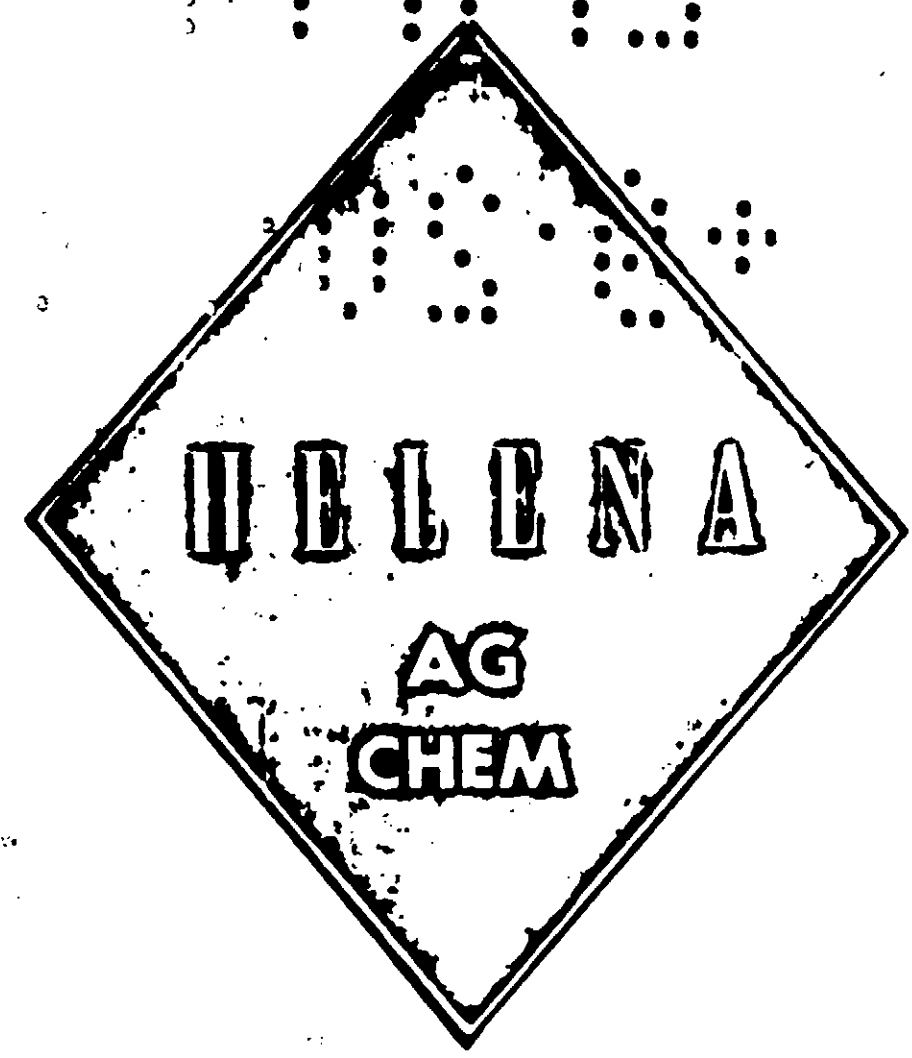

RECOMMENDATIONS

TOBACCO: FOR BLUE MOLD CONTROL —

In Plant Beds — Apply 10 to 13 pounds per 100 square yards. Begin dusting when the plants are the size of a dime and before blue mold is first reported in the area. Dust every three days (every two days after the Blue Mold appears).

In the Field — Apply 15 to 20 pounds per acre. Apply weekly as needed.
