SWEET CORN

CORN EARWORM — Use at the rate of one quart in 100 gallons of water per acre. Make the applications when the silks first appear and repeat applications at two to three day intervals.

Do not apply within 12 days of harvest.

Do not feed the treated forage to dairy animals or to animals used for meat production.
