How to Apply: For most insects, apply at a rate of 2 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. (20 $^{\prime}$ x 50 $^{\prime}$). For heavy lawns, such as St. Augustine grass, the rate should be increased to 3 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft.

For billbug and white grub control, the rate is 21½ lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. For best results, the lawn should be dry before application. To control surface feeding insects, armyworms and sod webworms (lawn moths). Water lawn lightly after application. To control ants, billbugs, chinch bugs, cutworms, and white grubs, water lawn thoroughly after

When to Apply:

Apply when insects are present. To control ants, armyworms, Bermudagrass mites, chinch bugs, cutworms, leathoppers, and sod webworms (lawn moths), apply at 4-6 week intervals.

To control white grubs, apply any time between July and early October. To control billbugs, apply when activity is first observed, or when chewed or brown grass indicates damage from these insects. Repeat

To control Hyperodes weevils (New York only):
Apply 2 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. of grass. Water grass thoroughly after apprication. Treat problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May.

Spot Treatment:
Ants: Apply 1½ teaspoons over and around each ant hill.
Digger Wasps: Apply 1½ teaspoons in and around each nest opening.
Apply an dusk when wasps are not active.

Band Treatment Around House Foundation:

The following pests are commonly found around or near foundations of houses as well as in lawns. Certain of these pests may enter houses.

When to Apply: Apply when insects are present, especially in late spring or early fall. Repeat as necessary.

Barden Insect Control:

Carrot Rust Files: Apply 7 oz. per 500 sq. ft. in seed furrow at planting time.

Onlon Maggots: Apply 4 oz. per 500 sq. ft. in seed furrow at planting time.

Sweat Potatoes (North Carolina Only)
Wireworms: Apply 11 oz. per 500 sq. ft. over the top of sweet potato
plant foliage when roots begin to enlarge.

Vinegar Fies (Drosophila spp.): Apply 4 oz. per 500 sq. ft. over top of plants when flies first appear. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals, or as required. Tomatoes may be picked the same day.

Turnips Root Maggots: Apply 4 oz. per 500 sq. ft. in seed furrow at planting
