DIRECTIONS

In dusting, be certain that the foliage is covered on both the upper and lower sides. Do not use when temperature is 85°F. or over. In very warm weather use in the morning when the temperature is down.

BEANS: To control Mexican Bean Beetle apply at the rate of 25 to 30 pounds per acre or 2 ounces per 50 feet of row. Make the first application when insects or egg masses on the underside of the leaves are first seen. Thorough application to the lower as well as the upper leaf surface is necessary for good results. Repeat applications at 7 to 10 day intervals as necessary for control. Do not treat vines that will be fed to dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not take internally avoid breathing dust. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin wash thoroughly after handling. Change contaminated clothing daily. Avoid contamination of Feed and Food Stuffs.

Do not feed plants treated with Sevin to meat or dairy animals
