SHAKE BEFORE USING

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Hold container upright. Point spray opening away from you and press button. Apply sparingly in short bursts.

INDOORS: TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, FLYING MOTHS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cubic feet). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, ANTS: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting the insects directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails, around window frames and door sills, and other locations. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL CLOTHES MOTHS: Spray all articles to be protected, giving particular attention to folds and seams. Spray interior of storage containers, such as closets, chests and trunks regularly. Treatment should be repeated every thirty days unless the articles are stored in a moth-tight container.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES: Spray repeatedly with liberal applications to baseboards, infested carpets, infested furniture, areas of shelving, corners and under furniture where these insects tend to congregate and cause damage.

TO KILL BEDBUGS: Spray mattresses thoroughly, especially around seams and tufts. Spray bedstead, baseboards, floor boards. Repeat frequently.

TO KILL APHIDS AND WHITE FLY ON HOUSE PLANTS: Spray in short bursts, holding the can 18 inches from foliage of English Ivy and African Violets. Spray both sides of the leaves lightly. Do not wet. Repeat as often as necessary.

OUTDOORS: For insects on Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Delphiniums, Gladiolus, Iris, Marigolds, Peonies, Roses and Sandragons. Also for insects on evergreens and small ornamental deciduous trees, shrubs and vines.

When sprayed directly on insects, this spray kills sucking insects: Aphids, Leafhoppers, Spider Mites, Thrips (exposed) and lace bugs. Kills chewing insects: Mexican Bean Beetles, Climbing Cutworms and Japanese Beetles when these insects are hit directly with spray.

For best results spray in evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Use slow sweeping motion. Keep can 18 inches from plants. Avoid wetting foliage with the spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray row on both sides. Repeat when needed. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth. Do not spray garden when temperature exceeds 90°F.
