CAUTION

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

If possible close space to be treated. Release three feet from any surface, holding the dispenser above the head. Moving the dispenser about while spraying will aid dispersion. Dispense only for time indicated. USE SPARINGLY. Seven seconds of spraying is ample for each 1,000 cubic feet (10' x 10' x 10'). Not necessary to spray directly on insects but merely release in the air since the aerosol will disperse throughout the enclosed space. Temporarily effective in sheltered out-door area.
