DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DORMANT EMULSION is a prepared dormant oil emulsion for use at 2% strength as a spreader and sticker for basic coppers and Bordeaux mixture; and at 4% to 5% strength for the control of leaf rollers, scale insects and mites during the full dormant period.

To obtain best results with this product, special attention should be given to the following: Use efficient equipment of the proper type; avoid spraying during or immediately prior to hot or freezing weather, hot dry winds, rain or other unsuitable conditions; avoid over-spraying or double-spraying. Plants should be sprayed only when in vigorous condition and when their moisture condition is suitable. Most local agricultural authorities issue specific recommendations covering the use of insecticides in their particular area.

MIXING DIRECTIONS

If there is any free oil on the surface, stir this into the emulsion. Measure out the proper amount of emulsion, and add it to the spray tank when the water is about the height of the agitator rod. The agitator should be in motion. If spreader is being used, add this when the tank is about two-thirds full.
